### <概要>

Policies on international cooperation depend on how engaged actors understand "development" - what they see as primary causes of the problem, how they decide on desirable goals, and what they judge as the most effective and efficient ways to intervene. In this class, we will first learn different theories that have emerged to date to understand "development." We will then analyze positions and policies of development actors including government agencies, international organizations, and NGOs (non-governmental organizations). The class will be taught in English.
